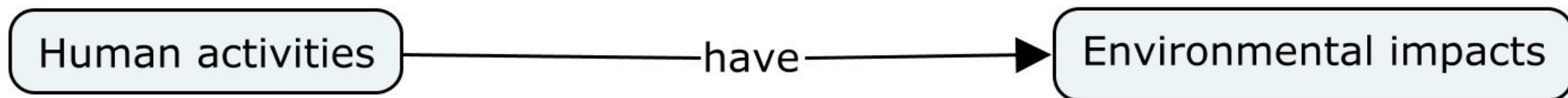

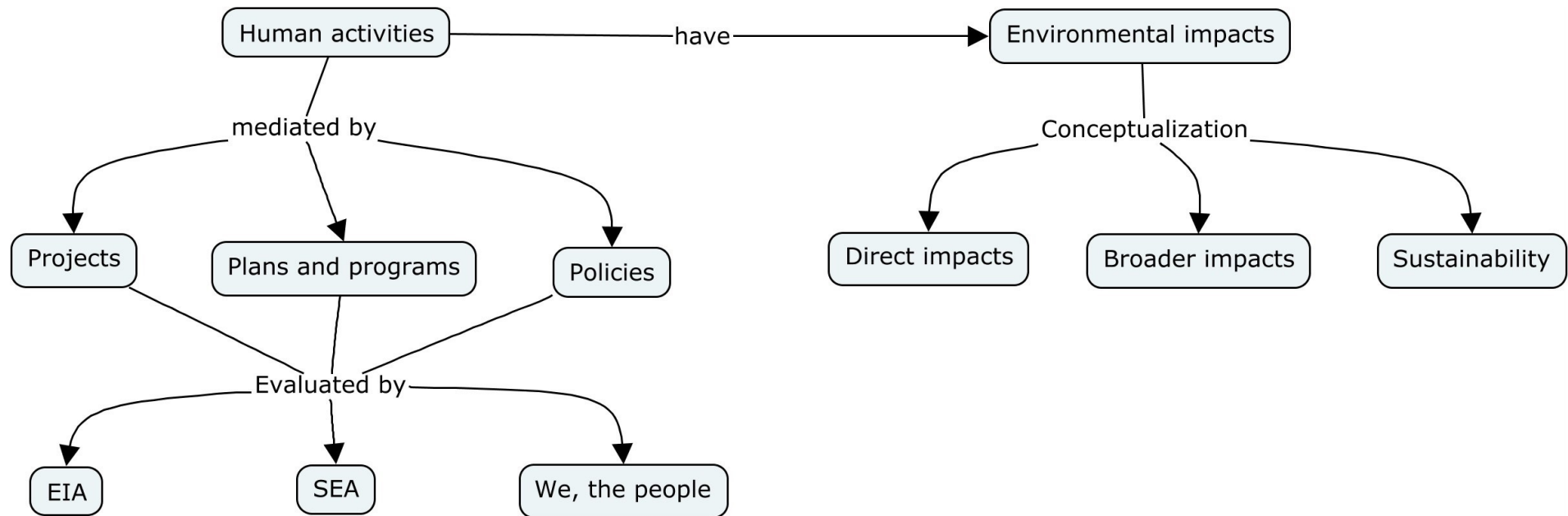

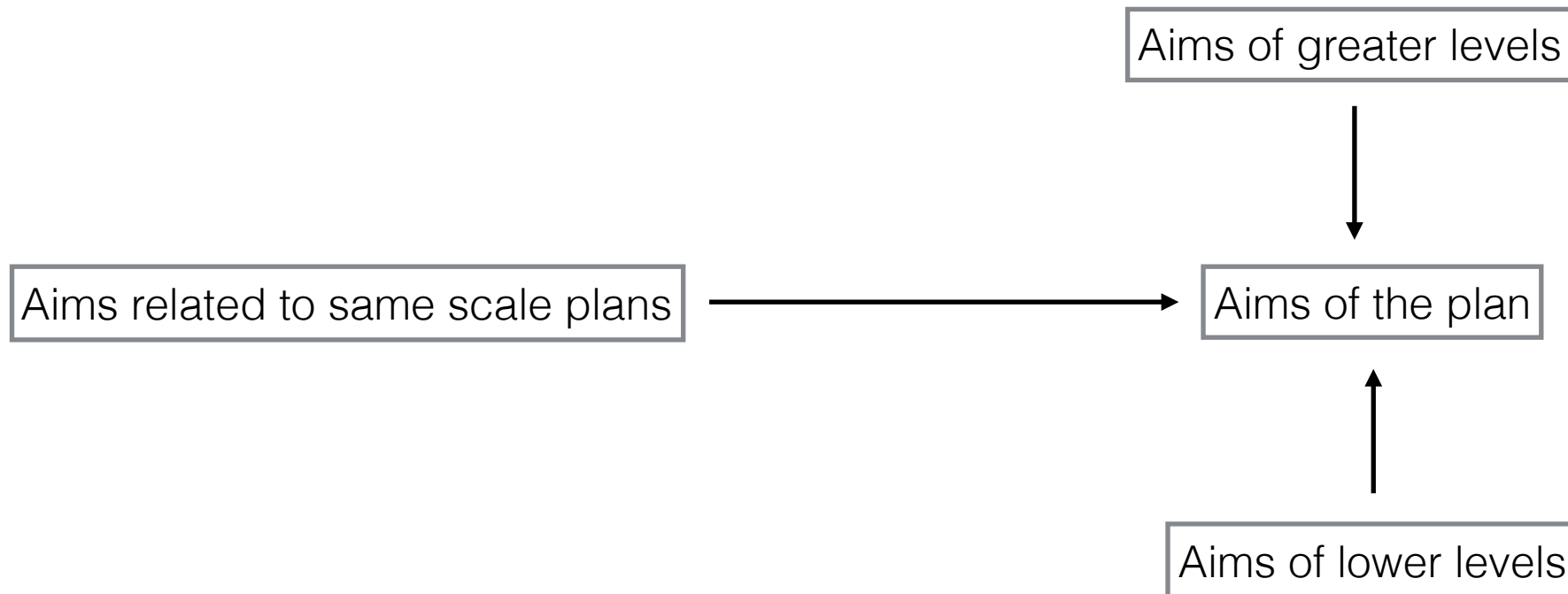
EIA

- Integration of both the public and local and regional authorities.

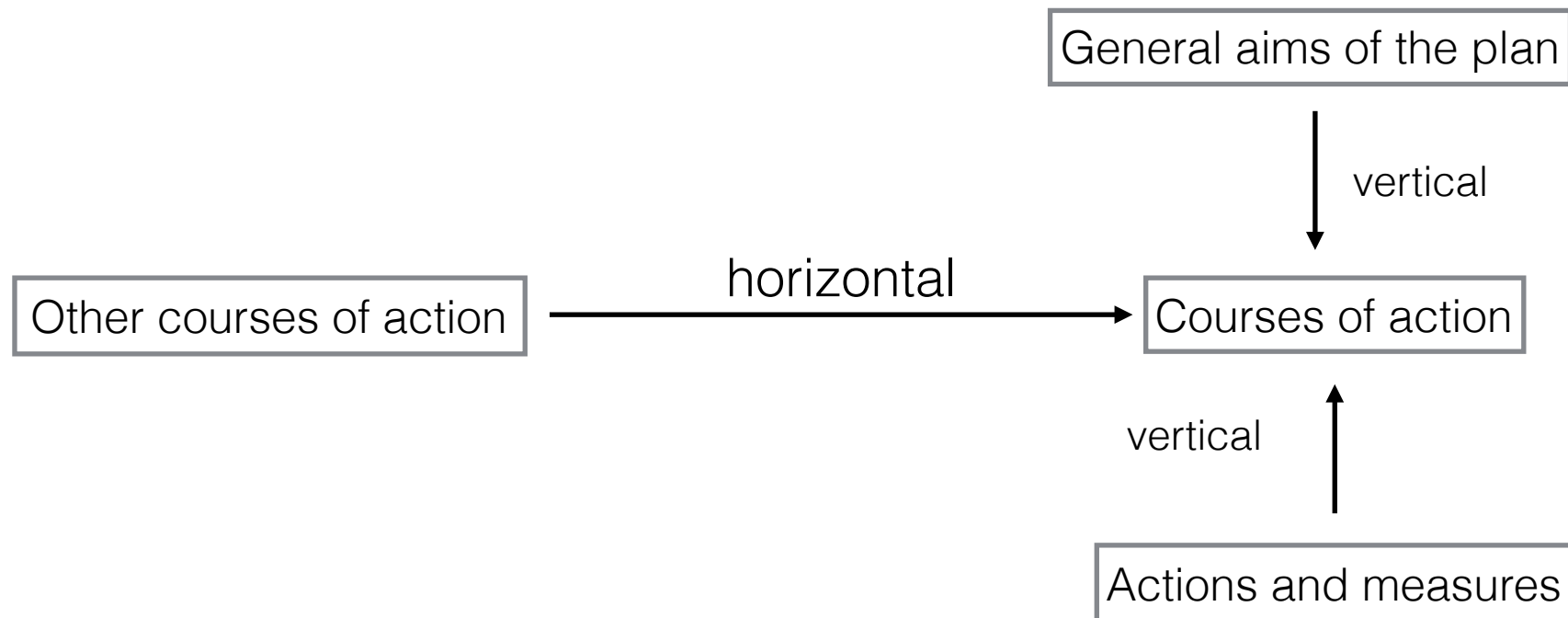
SEA

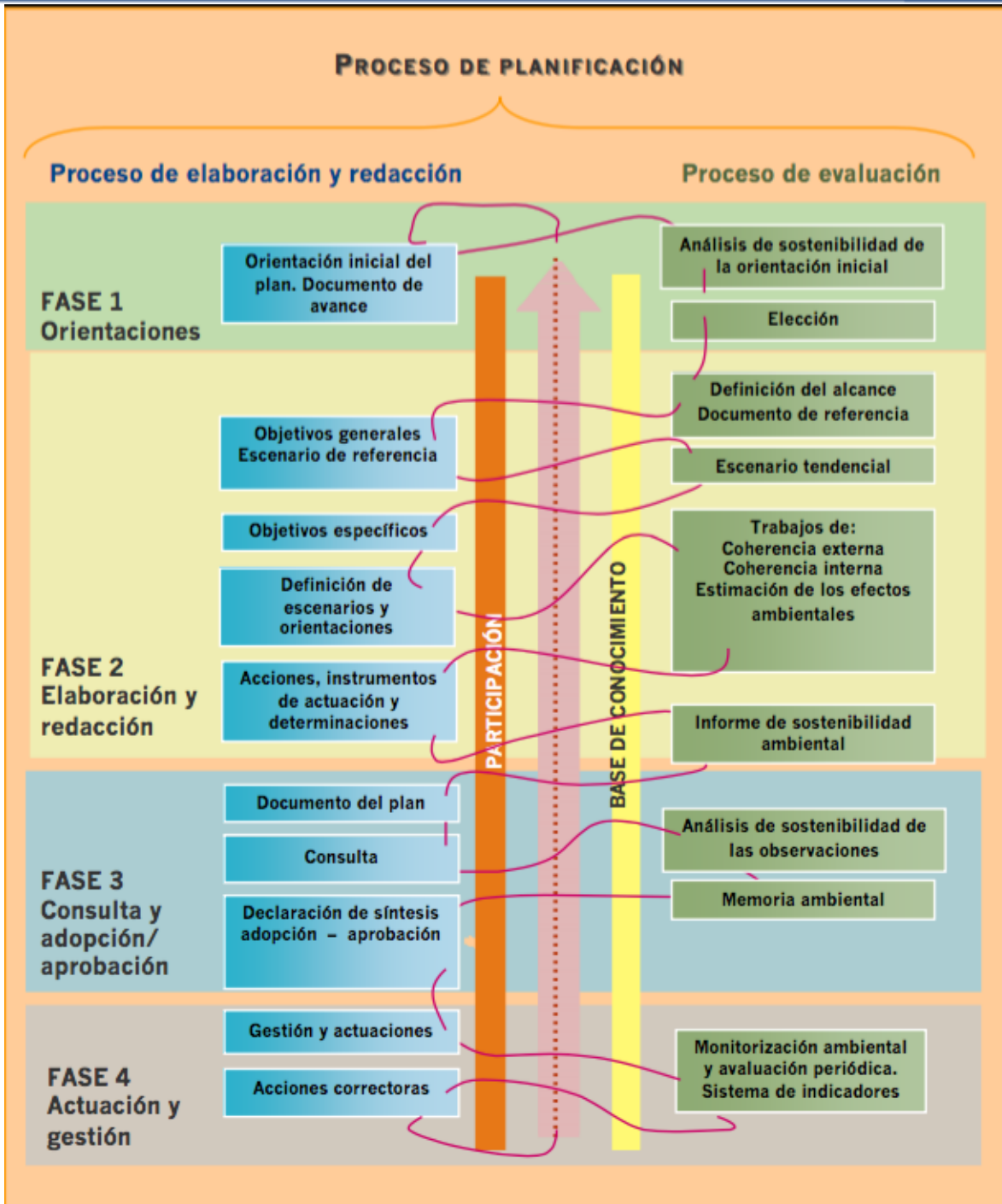
- Directive 2001/42/EC. Strategic.

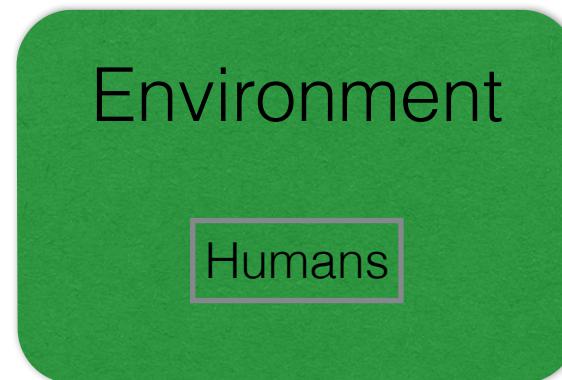
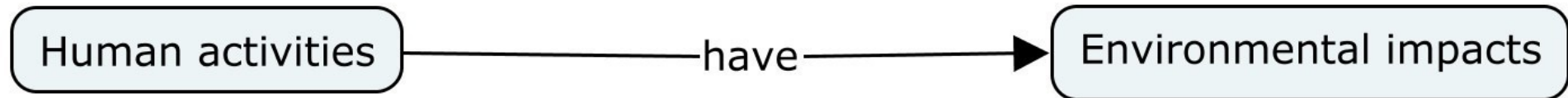
