OBJECT

Local Sustainable Development strategy for the Island of Gozo, developed through a bottom-up approach, that provides a set of practical recommendations and measures to achieve an enduring environmental improvement of the island and retain Gozo's cultural identity, while at the same time foster economic development and social progress.

REASON WHY YOU CHOSE IT/YOU CONSIDERED IT RELEVANT FOR THE PURPOSE OF ENEPLAN

EcoGozo frames energy planning in a multi-sectoral plan of actions, applying the sustainability concept to the multiple aspects of territorial governance (land use, economic development, social issues, etc.) and thus providing a useful basis to explore the interrelations among those issues that are relevant to improve a territory's eco-sustainability.
